FLORIDA CFO ALEX SINK TO SPEAK AT GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS LUNCHEON DURING THE FLORIDA CREDIT UNION LEAGUE'S ANNUAL MEETING IN ORLANDO, JUNE 15TH

ORLANDO, FLA. - Aletta Shutes, Florida Credit Union League (FCUL) Executive Vice President, is proud to announce Florida's Chief Financial Officer Alex Sink as the speaker for the Governmental Affairs Luncheon at this year's FCUL Annual Convention & Exposition. The luncheon is scheduled for June 15, 2007, from 12:15 p.m. – 2:15 p.m., in the Mediterranean 6 Room of the JW Marriott Orlando Grande Lakes at 4040 Central Florida Parkway.

“We are excited and honored to have CFO Sink speak to us at this event,” said FCUL Executive Vice President Aletta Shutes. “She has shown great leadership and willingness to work with credit unions and their specific regulatory and legislative issues in her short time as Florida’s CFO.”

Sink, a Democrat, was elected to the post last November and assumed office in January. In just her first few weeks in office, CFO Sink had to coordinate her department’s involvement in a special session on homeowners’ insurance, participate in relief activities for victims of the tornadoes that swept through central Florida, and take a leading role in developing new rules for both insurance companies and credit unions as a result of legislative activity.

Sink previously spoke to Florida credit unions at FCUL's Legislative Summit in March.
